

Outstanding Results at John Forrest

John Forrest was named in the prestigious: First 50 WACE Course Examination Schools Table in 2010 and 2011, First 50 Schools—VET Achievement Table in 2010, 2011 and 2012.

Outstanding results for 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 included: 98-100% Graduation Rate, consistently high median ATAR achieved by university pathway students and a Year 12 student achieving an ATAR of 99.6 in 2013 placing them in the top 1% of the State and a member of the 99 Club.

John Forrest Secondary College was listed in the WA Secondary School of the Year Awards and the National and WA VET in Schools Excellence Awards; winners of the National 2011 and WA VET in Schools Excellence 2012 Awards.

John Forrest Secondary College students were awarded University of WA, Edith Cowan University and Curtin University scholarships in 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014.

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What the Academic Excellence Program can offer You

The Academic Excellence Program is a school based academic extension program. It aims to engage students with materials that are complex and challenging and provides students with an environment in which high levels of thinking can be practised. Students are engaged in critical thinking games and stimulating assignments to achieve their full academic potential.

Eligibility

Entry to the Academic Excellence Program for Year 6 students is decided on the basis of primary school results, NAPLAN results, a John Forrest Secondary college testing program and a written application.

Enrolled Students

Students enrolled at John Forrest Secondary College are eligible to be considered for entry into the Academic Excellence Program and must be of above average academic ability in at least three out of four academic learning areas:

- English;
- Mathematics;
- Science; and
- Society & Environment

and must be recommended by their John Forrest Secondary College teachers.

Scholarships

Scholarships will be offered to Year 6 students applying for the Academic Excellence Program who demonstrate outstanding academic ability and citizenship qualities. Each scholarship recipient will receive a \$600 voucher to cover Year 7 Charges and Voluntary Contributions.
